# Thanks to the payment for our services, we can continue with our social programs:

### 1. Educational Program

The Educational Program of the MSI Foundation, called **"Sexual Education for All"** supports:

- Youth, parents, educators, and public officials with evidence-based and taboo-free sexual and reproductive health information

- Through in-person and virtual means
- Completely free through informational booths, workshops,
- conferences, and our educational platform Infosex.

In 2023, over 278,900 individuals in Mexico City, the Metropolitan Area, Oaxaca, and Chiapas received information about sexual and reproductive rights from our volunteers.

### 2. Midwives Program

We train over 621 midwives, birth attendants, and health promoters in the use and management of family planning methods, and we also provide them with supplies. With this program, we aim to:

- Reduce maternal mortality
- Empower women in these regions to take charge of their futures



### In 2023:

 We distributed 8,832 subsidized sexual and reproductive health supplies.
Across 230 municipalities in the states of Guerrero, Oaxaca, Morelos, Tabasco, Puebla, Michoacán, and Chiapas.

### 3. Subsidy Program

At the MSI Foundation, our goal is to ensure that no woman is denied access to health services due to economic reasons. Through this program, we provide total or partial subsidies, letting every woman know that they can rely on us. We've delivered over 16,568 subsidies in sexual and reproductive health supplies and services throughout Mexico.
